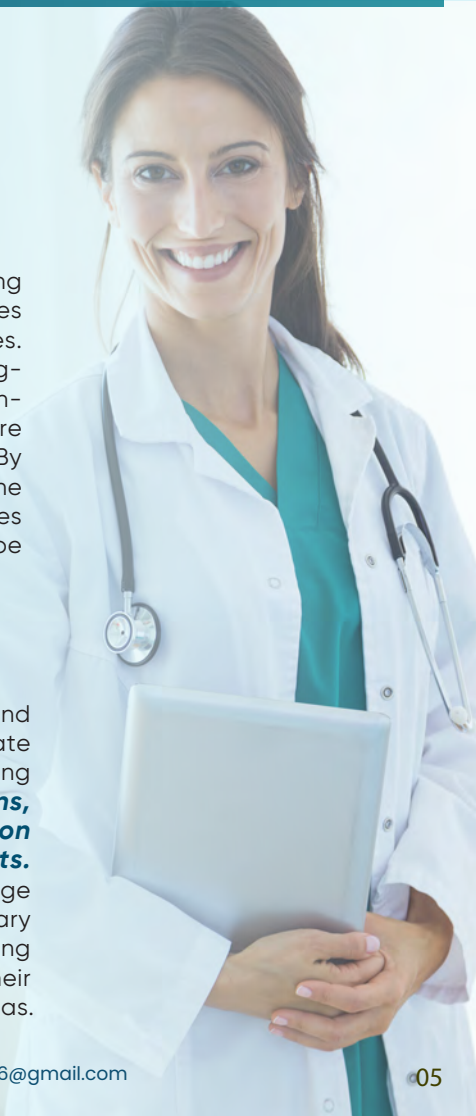

- PowerPoint Presentation is necessary for the presentation.
- Slides should be limited to 10, excluding the title slide at the start.
- Only relevant pictures (Investigations, Pathognomonic signs, etc.) should be added to the presentation.

Oral Presentation

Presentation rules :

- Participant must register as a delegate.
- Solo participation only.
- Presentation time: 6 minutes
- Followed by Q&A by the judges: 2 min
- PowerPoint Presentation is necessary for the presentation.
- Slides should be limited to 10, excluding the title slide at the start.

Poster Presentation

Presentation rules :

- Participants must register as a delegate.
- Solo participation only.
- Format: E-Poster
- Presentation time – 5 Minutes (exceeding the time limit leads to negative marking).
- The final poster should be sent to us in PDF format. (USB backup)
- Marks are awarded for presentation skills as well as the neatness of the poster.
